Why we chose to embark on this initiative OUR VISION



- Formatting a new breed of patriotic leaders exhibiting exceptional ethics and entrepreneurial skills
 - Addressing the root cause of poor leadership

 - Establish a network of leaders committed to tackling the nation's economic and social challenges

- Partnering with FGCE to invest in initiatives and programs aimed at graduating successive classes of exceptional students; guided a team of teachers with enriched teaching skills.

We set our vision into action PILOT RUN



- In keeping with our vision;
 - * In 2017, we assisted a select team of high achieving students in participating the Education USA Opportunity Program (OFP).
 - * A USA embassy sponsored scholarship program available to the less economically advanced countries.
 - * Out of the 14 students that enrolled in the program, 2 were successful
 - * The students were provided tutoring services, coaching, guidance and professional advice towards university applications and scholarships
 - * They wrote their SAT exams and have so far applied for full scholarships into 9 universities in the US and Canada
 - * 1st teacher training workshop headlined by Mrs. Ndidi Okonkwo Nwuneli was held on the 9th of November 2017
 - * Feedback from the teachers was overwhelmingly positive. They spoke to how motivated they were to drive through a change agenda in their students



- * Owning to the successful pilot run, we are encouraged and about set to expand on this initiative
 - * A second workshop is planned for Tuesday January 9th 2018.
 - * SAT Pre Test as part of the program schedule was conducted last week with results to be soon available.
- * A key lesson learnt is the awareness of several learning gaps for the students; a very urgent need to be met if our students will have a chance to be competitive in a dynamic economic and cultural environment

Program Implementation NEXT STEPS



- Full program kick off JAN 2018
- Partnership with LEAP Africa
 - A collaboration with LEAP Africa to establish their esteemed iLEAD leadership development program in FGCE
 - Availed to a select number of high achieving students in SS1 and SS2
- A smooth transition into the FGCE Student Leadership program as they graduate into SS3
 - Provide much needed support in the form of tutoring assistance
 - Coaching and mentoring services for the students
- Teacher enrichment training workshops and seminar
 - * Teachers are recognized as the catalyst and vehicles to drive change

iLEAD training with LEAP Africa

SS1 &SS2 students are enrolled in a weekly hands-on training program. The curriculum includes; self identity, values, vision, goal setting, communication skills, creativity and innovation.

Mentorship

This is a 6-9 month program where students in their final year of school, will be matched with alumni in their chosen career fields. This is a curriculum guided approach to coach and develop the potential in these students.

The aim is to promote ethical values, pride in the country as well as vision and career guidance.

School Trips and summer work programs

Students are encouraged and assisted to obtain summer internships. This is to acquire leadership experience, work ethics, industry awareness and the skills to build self confidence.

I.T. Resource Utilization

The school computer lab and IT resources will be made available to the students for university preparation. Examples include the Khan Academy Tutoring, Instructional videos etc.



WAEC tutoring and SAT preparation

The use of a structured tutoring in Mathematics and English, designed to ensure full preparedness of the SS3 students for university entrance in Nigeria, Africa, USA, Canada and England. Initial comparative syllabus analysis to be conducted at onset to ensure maximum impact of delivered content.

University/Scholarship Application Support

Guidance will be provided through the University and scholarship selection and application process.

Teacher Training Workshops

Workshops will be arranged for training and capacity building of the teachers. Three workshops are to be held every year.

Teacher Motivational Initiatives For recognition and reward of outstanding teachers as well as the encouragement of peer recognition.
